#### Summary of Change Requested:

Change to games rules for Windsor Castle and Moat and Castle to remove the requirement that, if the bucket is knocked over, there is enough water left in the bucket to float the ball/orb.

#### Current Rule Book Wording:

Windsor Castle:

If the bucket is knocked over it must contain enough water to float the orb.

Moat and Castle:

If the bucket is knocked over, there must be enough water left in it to float a ball.

#### Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

Windsor Castle:

If the bucket is knocked over, it must be replaced on the spot, regardless of whether there is any water left or not.

Moat and Castle:

If the bucket is knocked over, it must be replaced on the spot, regardless of whether there is any water left or not.

Reason for Change Request:

If the bucket is knocked over and has to be replaced, the team have already been penalised enough without also incurring an elimination for not having sufficient water in the bucket.
