Summary of Change Requested:

Change to rules for Association Race, Bank Race and Founders Race to remove the possibility for the 4th rider to correct mistakes made by the first three.

Current Rule Book Wording:

Association Race (Team):

During the race, upset containers do not necessarily have to be replaced in the correct order but the last rider to go must ensure that the centre line stack spells M (green), G (yellow), A (blue), G (red), B (white) from top to bottom before crossing the finish line.

Association Race (Pairs):

During the race, upset containers do not necessarily have to be replaced in the correct order but Rider 2 must ensure that the stack reads correctly before crossing the finish line.

Bank Race:

During the race, the numbers do not necessarily have to be placed on the board in the correct order, or with the black side facing outwards, but the last rider to go must ensure that the cheque reads £1000, with all the numbers showing in black, before finishing the race.

Founders Race:

Each rider completes the course in the same way. During the race the cartons do not have to be placed on the pole in the correct order but the last rider must ensure that the cartons are placed correctly to spell N PATRICK, reading from top to bottom of the pole, before crossing the Start/Finish line.

Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

Association Race & Bank Race:
Remove above wording completely.

Founds Race:
Each rider completes the course in the same way with their respective letters. At the end of the race the carton must be placed correctly on the pole to spell N PATRICK, reading from top to bottom of the pole.

Reason for Change Request:

One of the overriding concepts of Mounted Games is that all riders must correct their won mistakes. By allowing the 4th rider to correct errors made by one of the first three riders, the rules are unnecessarily complicated. This can also cause confusion amongst the watching public.
