#### Summary of Change Requested:

Part 5 of a multi part Rule Change covering all games. Aim is to make the wording of all games consistent.

This one covers Bank Race.

#### Current Rule Book Wording:

##### Team (2010 rule book) :

Rider 1 rides to the road cone, collects a number, rides to the stand, hangs the number on a hook on the stand so that the black side of the number faces outwards and returns to cross the Start/Finish Line. Riders 2, 3, and 4 complete the course in the same way. Numbers should be placed on the board from the mounted position at all times.

##### Individual (2010 rule book) :

The rider rides to the cone, collects a number, rides to the stand and hangs the number on a hook on the stand. He/she then returns to collect each number singly so that the cheque reads £1000 before crossing the finish line. Numbers do not necessarily have to be placed on the board in any correct order or with the black side facing outwards but the rider must ensure that the Cheque reads £1000 with all numbers showing in black before completing the game. Numbers must be hung on the stand from the mounted position.

#### Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

##### Team :

Rider 1 rides to the cone, collects a number, rides to the stand, hangs the number on a hook on the board with the black side showing, and rides to cross the Start/Finish line.

Riders 2, 3, and 4 repeat the actions of Rider 1.

Riders must place the number they have taken from the cone from the mounted position (rule CR5.1 does not apply for this action). Numbers already on the board which are displaced may be replaced from the ground.

The numbers may be collected from the cone in any order, but must be hung on the board in the correct position so that it reads 1, 0, 0, 0 from left to right with all numbers showing black.

Individual :

The rider rides to the cone, collects a number, rides to the stand, and hangs the number on a hook on the board with the black side showing.

The rider then rides to collect and hang each of the other numbers individually, and rides to cross the Start/Finish line.

Numbers must be placed on the board from the mounted position (rule CR5.1 does not apply for this action). Numbers already on the board which are displaced may be replaced from the ground.

The numbers may be collected from the cone in any order, but must be hung on the board in the correct position so that it reads 1, 0, 0, 0 from left to right with all numbers showing black.

Reason for Change Request:

Brings consistency to the wording of all games in the rule book and eliminates "grey areas".

Team :

Rider 1 rides to the cone, collects a number, rides to the stand, hangs the number on a hook on the board with the black side showing, and rides to cross the Start/Finish line.

Riders 2, 3, and 4 repeat the actions of Rider 1.

Riders must place the number they have taken from the cone from the mounted position (rule CR5.1 does not apply for this action). Numbers already on the board which are displaced may be replaced from the ground.

The numbers may be collected from the cone in any order, but must be hung on the board in the correct position so that it reads 1, 0, 0, 0 from left to right with all numbers showing black.

Individual :

The rider rides to the cone, collects a number, rides to the stand, and hangs the number on a hook on the board with the black side showing.

The rider then rides to collect and hang each of the other numbers individually, and rides to cross the Start/Finish line.

Numbers must be placed on the board from the mounted position (rule CR5.1 does not apply for this action). Numbers already on the board which are displaced may be replaced from the ground.

The numbers may be collected from the cone in any order, but must be hung on the board in the correct position so that it reads 1, 0, 0, 0 from left to right with all numbers showing black.

Reason for Decision:
