Summary of Change Requested:

Part 16 of a multi part Rule Change covering all games. Aim is to make the wording of all games consistent.

This one covers Moat and Castle.

Current Rule Book Wording:

Individual (2010 rule book) :

The rider rides to the bucket, retrieves a tennis ball, rides to the cone and places the ball on top of the cone. On the return he/she collects the second tennis ball from the bucket and rides over the finish line carrying it. If the bucket is knocked over, there must be enough water left in it to float a ball. If the tennis ball falls to the ground whilst attempting to place it on the cone, the error may be corrected mounted or dismounted.

Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

Individual (proposed for 2012) :

The rider rides to the bucket on the centre line, collects a ball, rides to the cone at the changeover end and places the ball on top of the cone. The rider then collects the second ball from the bucket and rides to cross the Start/Finish carrying it.

If the bucket is knocked over, it must be replaced on its mark upright with enough water left in it to float a ball.

Reason for Change Request:

Brings consistency to the wording of all games in the rule book and eliminates "grey areas".
