Summary of Change Requested:

Add a new team game of Ball and Cone

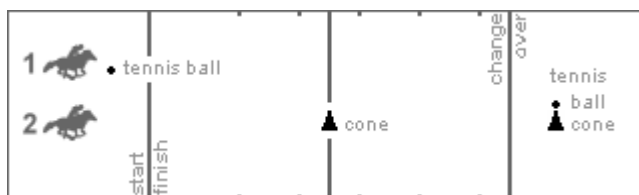
Current Rule Book Wording:

Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

#### **Ball and Cone**

1 cone on the centre line, and 1 cone with 1 tennis ball on the 2 yard (1.8m) mark at the changeover end, offset between the bending pole lines. Rider 1 starts with a tennis ball.



Rider 1 rides to the cone on the centre line, places the ball on it, rides to the cone at the changeover end, collects the ball from it, and rides to hand it over to Rider 2.

Rider 2 rides to the cone at the changeover end, places the ball on it, rides to the cone on the centre line, collects the ball from it, and rides to hand it over to the next rider.

Rider 3 repeats the actions of Rider 1, and rider 4 repeats the actions of Rider 2, finishing with the ball.

Reason for Change Request:

The game lends itself easily to being a team game and is commonly used as such. Having an additional game in the rule book which uses equipment that is already available would provide variety.

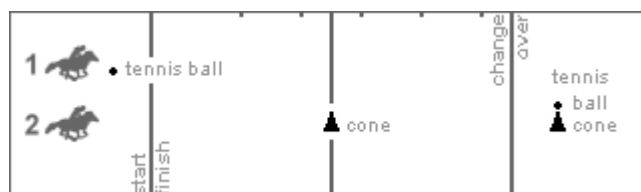

Actual Adopted New Rule Book Wording:

**Ball and Cone**

1 cone on the centre line, and 1 cone with 1 tennis ball on the 2 yard (1.8m) mark at the changeover end, offset between the bending pole lines. Rider 1 starts with a tennis ball.



Rider 1 rides to the cone on the centre line, places the ball on it, rides to the cone at the changeover end, collects the ball from it, and rides to hand it over to Rider 2.  
Rider 2 rides to the cone at the changeover end, places the ball on it, rides to the cone

on the centre line, collects the ball from it, and rides to hand it over to the next rider. Rider 3 repeats the actions of Rider 1, and rider 4 repeats the actions of Rider 2, finishing with the ball.
