#### Summary of Change Requested:

Clarification to the positioning of equipment in Sword Lancers.

#### Current Rule Book Wording:

##### **Individuals**

4 bending poles in the first 4 positions (only 2 rings on poles 2 and 3 for Under 12's) with 1 sword ring attached to each pole, and 1 sword in 1 cone on the 2 metre mark at the changeover end, in line with the bending poles. Rings on all poles on the Start/Finish line side of the pole.

#### Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

##### **Individuals**

4 bending poles in the first 4 positions (only 2 rings on poles 2 and 3 for Under 12's) with 1 sword ring attached to each pole, and 1 sword in 1 cone (with the handle pointing away from the changeover line) on the 2 metre mark at the changeover end, in line with the bending poles. Rings on all poles on the Start/Finish line side of the pole.

#### Reason for Change Request:

Makes it clear exactly how the equipment is to be set out and ensures that it is the same for all competitors.
