Summary of Change Requested:

There has been some discussion recently about how/if tie break races are counted in terms of rule GR1.10.

This changes looks to clarify this.

Current Rule Book Wording:

GR1.10. No pony can compete in more than 24 games on any day nor in more than 96 games in any seven days (In team competitions, the 5th pony is deemed to have taken part in a race).

Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

GR1.10. No pony can compete in more than 24 games on any day (including tie breaks) nor in more than 96 games in any seven days (In team competitions, the 5th pony is deemed to have taken part in a race).

Reason for Change Request:

It is currently unclear whether tie break races are to be included in the count but logic would seem to dictate that if the limit is 24 in a day then why should a tie break race be treated differently?
