Summary of Change Requested:

New Game suggested by Andrew Rodaughan – Flag Runners Race

Current Rule Book Wording:

No existing rule

Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

TEAM VERSION

1 flag cone on the centre line, containing one Red, White, Blue and Green flag each. One Four Flag Holder on the 2 metre mark at the changeover line. Rider 1 Starts with a Yellow flag

Rider 1 rides to the 4 flag holder, places the Yellow Flag in its correct holder, returns to the centre line and collects any coloured flag (other than Green), and changes over with rider 2

Riders 2 and 3 repeat the actions of Rider 1, placing the coloured flag in its correct holder

Rider 4 repeats the actions of the other riders, finishing with the Green Flag in hand

Riders must be mounted when placing the flag into the holder (rule CR6.2 does not apply for this action), but if the holder is knocked over (or any flags placed in by a previous rider are knocked out), flags may be replaced either mounted or dismounted, including their own, providing it had already been placed into the holder prior to it being knocked over. Colour matching of flags and holders must be respected at all times.

PAIRS VERSION

1 flag cone on the centre line, containing one Red, White, Blue and Green flag each. One Four Flag Holder on the 2 metre mark at the changeover line. Rider 1 Starts with a Yellow flag

Rider 1 rides to the 4 flag holder, places the Yellow Flag in its correct holder, returns to the centre line and collects any coloured flag (other than Green). This flag may be placed in its correct holder at the changeover line, or returned to Rider 2 at the Start/Finish line.

The remaining flags are collected individually from the cone at the centreline and placed in the matching holder by either rider, provided that the second rider places at least one flag in its holder, before crossing the Start/Finish line with the Green Flag in hand

Riders must be mounted when placing the flag into the holder (rule CR6.2 does not apply for this action), but if the holder is knocked over (or any flags placed in by a previous rider are knocked out), flags may be replaced either mounted or dismounted, including their own, providing it had already been placed into the holder prior to it being knocked over. Colour matching of flags and holders must be respected at all times.

INDIVIDUAL VERSION

1 flag cone on the centre line, containing one Red, Blue and Green (or Yellow) flag each. One Triple Flag Holder on the 2 metre mark at the changeover line. Rider Starts with a White flag

Rider 1 rides to the Triple flag holder and places the White Flag in its correct holder, The rider returns to the centre line, collecting the remaining flags individually, and placed in the holder in the same way. The rider then collects the Green (or Yellow) Flag last, and crosses the Start/Finish line

Riders must be mounted when placing the flag into the holder (rule CR6.2 does not apply for this action), but if the holder is knocked over (or any flags placed in by a previous rider are knocked out), flags may be replaced either mounted or dismounted, including their own, providing it had already been placed into the holder prior to it being knocked over. Colour matching of flags and holders must be respected at all times.
