#### Summary of Change Requested:

Common practice is for bank numbers on the code to be red facing out during the entire race. However, the orientation of the letter is only described in the game setup. Hence there is no requirement for the red facing out to be maintained during the game.

#### Current Rule Book Wording:

Bank Race  
<race setup>  
1 cone with number holder and 4 numbers with the red side outwards on the centre line.

#### Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

The numbers may be collected from the cone in any order, but must be hung on the board in the correct position so that it reads 1, 0, 0, 0 from left to right with all numbers showing black. **Numbers when on the cone must face with the red outwards at all times during the race.**

Just tightens the interpretation as currently refereed.
