Summary of Change Requested:

Errors must be corrected such that the race is reset to the point where the error was made

Current Rule Book Wording:

CR11.2. Errors must be undone and then corrected in the right sequence before proceeding.

Suggested New Rule Book Wording:

Errors must be corrected such that the race is reset to the point where the error was made

In the case of pairs and teams, errors made by a previous rider must be corrected by the "active" rider such that the race is reset to the point where the error was made. The race is then continued from the point the error was made.

Reason for Change Request:

removes confusion for riders and assistant/referees trying to keep track of riders needing to "reverse" turning an end pole in eg bottle exchange, individual two flag, mug shuffle etc
Kinder to ponies, allowing riders to keep to their initial track in the above examples
There is no defined "sequence" for correcting errors - it is just generally accepted that they be reversed in the order that they happen
Simplifies the correction of multiple errors in the same game, especially if errors are fixed "incorrectly".

The second part is to indicate what should happen if a mistake is noticed later in the game (e.g. a letter in founders race put on upside down), and to simplify the process of rectifying this mistake
