

Composite Teams – Under 12 European Team Championships

Purpose

The purpose of composite teams is to provide riders from member countries that do not ordinarily field a team at the Under 12 European Team Championships with the opportunity to participate in the Championships.

Eligibility

1. Only riders from member countries that have not previously achieved a podium placing at the European Team Championships shall be eligible to compete as part of a composite team.
2. A rider whose member country already has an official Under 12 team entry in the competition shall not be eligible to compete as part of a composite team.
3. All riders competing as part of a composite team must have the permission of their home member country.
4. A composite team may be formed from riders representing two or more member countries from anywhere in the world.

Entry and Administration

5. The official entry for a composite team shall be submitted by the member country providing the greatest number of riders.
6. The member country submitting the entry shall assume responsibility for the composite team and its riders in the same manner as for a full national team entry. This shall include responsibility for the appointment of team officials, who may be from any member country, with due regard to child protection requirements, and for the provision of team kit.

Championship Title

7. Only national teams shall be eligible to win the Championship title.

8. In the event of a composite team finishing in first place overall, the highest placed national team shall be declared the Championship winner.
